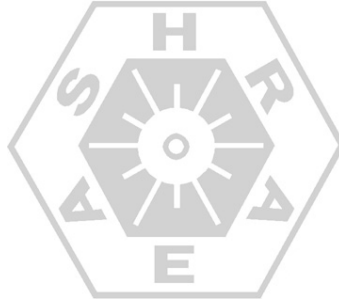

MAIN PROGRAM – LEED BUILDING FACILITATION AND COMMISSIONING SERVICES

BACKGROUND: The primary role of the Commissioning Authority for a LEED certified building is to verify that the building's energy related systems are installed, calibrated, and performing according to the owner's project requirements, the basis of design, and construction documents. The benefits of commissioning include reduced energy use, lower operating costs, fewer contractor callbacks, better building documentation, improved occupant productivity, and verification of the owner's project requirements. This program focuses on requirements of the United States Green Building Council LEED certification program, with an emphasis on the fundamental and enhanced commissioning of the building's energy related systems. The Commissioning Authority is responsible for development of commissioning plan, including development of systems installation checklists and functional testing procedures; execution of commissioning activities including functional testing of mechanical, plumbing, and electrical systems; conducting commissioning kick-off meetings and lessons learned meetings; and assisting the design and construction teams in troubleshooting.
