MAIN PROGRAM – VARIABLE REFRIGERANT FLOW (VRF) SYSTEMS

BACKGROUND: Variable refrigerant flow, or VRF, systems are very popular in Asia and Europe. It is only recently have they become more popular in the United States. In Japan, VRF Systems are used in nearly 50% of medium-sized commercial buildings (up to 70,000 ft²), and 33% of large commercial buildings (over 70,000 ft²), (Smith, L. 2006. "A Daikin Perspective on VRF." Daikin Air Conditioning U.K.) In this presentation, we will look at the history of variable refrigerant flow systems and the basic operation of these systems. We will discover the many benefits of these types of systems as well as look at what the future may hold.
